



City of Boulder Construction Update

West End Streetscape –

Street Resurfacing Planned for

Saturday, July 19 & Wednesday, July 23

(both early morning until noon)

As a part of the project, the city of Boulder has a planned resurfacing of Pearl and 10th street scheduled. Construction crews will be milling (removing a layer of asphalt) on Saturday morning on 10th and a part of Pearl (10th and Pearl intersection) then returning on Wednesday to overlay (new asphalt and striping) the streets. This will finish the work planned in both areas. The city has scheduled this work for these times for a couple of reasons. First, this gets the job done quicker so they can continue to move ahead. Second, they need to meet scheduling and equipment availability that is outside of their control.

City of Boulder staff will be on hand each morning to ensure that the project moves forward as quickly as possible. Parking on 10th to be closed during operation, open by noon. The intent is to have each days tasks completed and crews gone by noon. Please understand that circumstances outside of their control (i.e. weather) may cause us to alter this schedule. Thank you for your continued patience.
